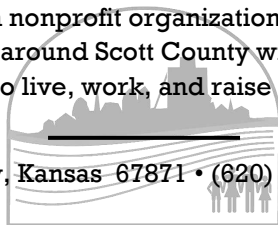
- \$1,000 postsecondary scholarships awarded to two students;

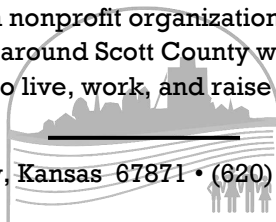
