Continuing Education Scholarships

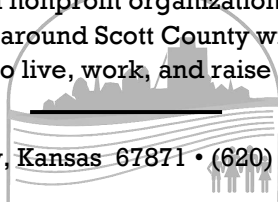
- Eight \$1000 postsecondary scholarships (Seven Everett Hueftle and one Duff Family) awarded; four to men and four to women
- Student must enroll in the college, junior college, trade school, or technical school of their choice no later than the Fall 2010 term. Winners will be notified in April 2010.
- Qualifying courses of study are an associate, bachelor, master, or doctorate degrees
- Student must be a current resident of Scott County or have graduated from SCHS prior to 2009

A committee will review the scholarship applications and recommend winners based on the following criteria. Percentages indicate the relative weight for each criterion.

- Well defined academic and career goals (Question I - 45%)
- Discuss your current level of community involvement and your future plans (Question II - 35%)
- Academic performance (20%)
