### **Future of Healy Scholarships**

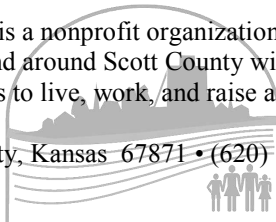
- \$500 postsecondary scholarship awarded to one student
- Student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 on a 4.00 scale
- Student must enroll full-time in the college, junior college, trade school, or technical school of their choice for the Fall 2010 term

**A committee will review the scholarship applications and recommend winner based on the following criteria. Percentages indicate relative weight for each criterion.**

- Well defined academic and career goals (Essay I - 20%)
- Past, present, and future involvement with the Scott community (Essay II - 20%)
- Academic performance (verified by SCHS official - 20%)
- High school activities (20%)
- Written communication (overall organization; clarity of essays and application - 20%)
