Scholarships

- \$5,000 postsecondary scholarships awarded to 1 male and 1 female
- Student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 on a 4.00 scale
- Hueftle and Hoffman applicants must enroll full-time in a college or technical school for the Fall 2010 term. Hoffman applicants must attend a school within the State of Kansas.
- Hoffman scholarships only — Brief interview with Foundation Trustees. Finalists will be notified by Mrs. Wilkinson and must be available for interviews in April 2010.

A committee of Scott Community members will review the scholarship applications and make recommendations to the Scott Community Foundation.

Everett Hueftle Scholarships

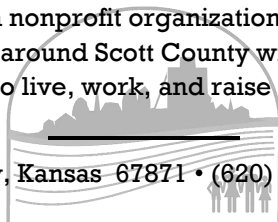
- \$1,500 postsecondary scholarships awarded to two students (1 male and 1 female)
- \$1,000 postsecondary scholarships awarded to five students
- Student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 on a 4.00 scale
- \$1,000 Vocational Technical Scholarship awarded to one student

Glenn Novak Scholarship

- \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship will be awarded to one student
- Student must be attending a College or University with the intent of obtaining a degree in an agricultural or animal sciences related field.
- Student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 on a 4.00 scale
