The Everett Hueftle Scott Community High School Scholarship Fund was established to ensure the future endeavors of graduates of Scott Community High School. There are seven \$1,000 post-secondary scholarships that will be awarded.

DUFF FAMILY CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Duff Family Scholarship is a post-secondary \$1,000 scholarship for continuing ed students. This scholarship was started to assist Scott County youth in the continuation of their college education.
