RALPH & BESSIE GROPP MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This scholarship is made available by the family of Ralph & Bessie Gropp in honor and response to their commitment to the needs of Western Kansas. Ralph & Bessie Gropp felt fortunate to have received excellent educational and medical services for themselves and their families. It was their wish to assist qualified students in the pursuit of careers in Education or Medicine.

HANK ROBERTSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This \$500 scholarship is made available by the family of Hank Robertson in honor and response to their commitment to the needs of Western Kansas. The family of Hank would like to assist a Greeley County senior with their educational costs. Preference is to a student involved in FFA program, and is possibly renewable for one year based on eligibility and funds.

LABACHE AG. INC, SCHOLARSHIP

Labache Ag. Inc. Education Fund was started in 2015 as a way to support local youth who aspire to a higher education and seek the resources to do so. This scholarship is available to students attending school in Scott County, Rawlins County, and Wallace County (Weskan and Wallace).

- \$2,500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student for two years (second year if the student qualifies)
- Student who has the capabilities of getting a college degree but because of financial burden cannot go to college or may not even think or consider getting a college degree.
- Lack of family support to get a degree
- Priority is given to second-generation immigrants that may or may not be legal in the US.
