A committee will review the anonymous scholarship applications and recommend winners based on the following criteria.

Future Plans, Community Involvement, High School Activities, Academic Achievment, & Written Communication

Woodrow & Loyal Hoffman Scholarships

- \$5,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students (I male and I female)
- Student must have cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Hueftle and Hoffman applicants must enroll full-time in college or technical school for the Fall 2021 term. Hoffman applicants must attend a school within the State of Kansas.
- Hoffman scholarships only-brief interview with Foundation Trustees. Finalists will be notified by Mrs. Price and must be available for interview.

Scott Community Foundation Scholarship

- \$2,500 total (\$1,500 from SCF & \$1,000 from Hueftle)
- Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students
- I male and I female; Hoffman interviewees

Everett Hueftle Scholarships

- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to six students
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

Helmers Family Scholarship

- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student
- Student must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Renewable for four years subject to funding and student maintaining a 3.0 GPA

Glenn Novak Scholarships

- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship will be awarded to two
- Student must be attending a College or University with the intent of obtaining a degree in an Agricultural or Animal Sciences related field.
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale Albert & Dee Hoeme Memorial Scholarship
- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

- \$7,500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students for two years (\$3,750 each year) Student who has the capabilities of getting a college degree but
- because of financial burden cannot go to college or may not even think or consider getting a college degree.
- Lack of family support to get a degree
- Priority given to second generation of immigrants that may or may not be legal in the US.

Don & Marlo Wiechman Scholarship

\$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one female SCHS Basketball player and \$500 to one male SCHS football and/or basketball player

Ruby Wilkens Music Scholarship

- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one
- Student must be pursuing degree in a music related field Security State Bank Scholarship
- \$1000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students
- Based on Community Involvement

Western State Bank Scholarship

- \$1000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student SC College Fund Scholarship
- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student
- Renewable for 4 years & Based on need

Raymond & Hildred Armantrout Scholarship

- \$4,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students for two years (\$2,000 each year)
- Student must be in top 1/3 of class
- Student must be pursuing bachelor's degree in any field <u>Larry Vulgamore Memorial Scholarship</u>
- \$1,500 Post-Secondary, 4 year Scholarship
- Student must be pursuing degree in an agricultural
- Applicant must be a child of current employee of **Vulgamore Family Farms**
- Renewable Subject to funding

William Dryer Memorial Scholarship

- \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale

SC Football Scholarship

\$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student athlete involved in the SCHS Football program (player, manager, trainer or BBN crew)

Lucas Matthies Memorial Scholarship

- The BIG HIT \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student athlete involved in the SCHS Football
- The BIG STICK \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student athlete involved in the SCHS Baseball OR Softball

Marsha Grothusen Scholarship Program

\$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one SCHS Senior entering the medical field; Must attach a 500 word essay on "how would you solve the issue of our rural doctor shortage?"

Kenneth & Jacque Snow Memorial Scholarship

 \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate who will be attending a vocational school.

Keith Burgess Aviation Scholarship

 Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate who will be attending aviation school. Amount TBD.

Marilyn & Whitney Walker Memorial Scholarship

 Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate who will be pursuing an Education Degree. Amount TBD.

- Open to any Scott Community High School Senior who are planning to major in Agriculture, attend a Vo-Tech school or major in Welding. Students applying must plan to attend either a University, Junior College, or Vo-Tech School in the school year following graduation.

 \$5000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate who will be attending a vocational school.
